Green PB – What is Covered?








Capital only – no staff or running costs

Green PB Process



DESIGN THE PROCESS

The Fund criteria is created and engagement planned



BRAINSTORM

IDEAS

Think about your ideas with others within your group or community



PROJECTS

IN ACTION

The funding is spent, and the projects start



DEVELOP

PROPOSAL

Develop ideas into a feasible capital proposal and make sure that all the criteria are met



FUND WINNING PROJECT

The projects that get the most votes are allocated funding



VOTE

Everyone in the local authority area votes on the proposals and chooses the ones they feel best to meet the needs of the community and contribute to reducing negative impacts on the environment



Applications closed on Monday 14th November

Aberdeen City: Area 70 sq miles;

Population 227,560; density 1164/km2

- 39 Funding Applications
- Totalling £1,057,131

Aberdeenshire: Area 2439 sq miles;

Population 261,210; density 36/km2

- 54+ Funding Applications
- Totalling £1,048,000 +

Moray: Area 864 sq miles; Population 95,820; density 39/km2

- 34 Funding Applications
- Totalling £989,382

Done well, PB helps to:

- Build strong relationships locally
- Create opportunities for groups and applicants to learn more about each other

What is Just Transition?

DEFINITION: A just transition is both the **outcome** – a fairer, greener future for all, and the **process** - must be undertaken in partnership with those impacted by the transition to net zero

It is **how** we get to **a net zero and climate resilient economy** in a way that **delivers fairness** and tackles inequality and injustice.

A just transition:

- Unites economic, social and climate objectives
- Aims to empower all to play a part in the transition to net zero
- Ensures those most impacted are at the heart of the conversation
- Accounts for differing risks and opportunities





















Net Zero? Just Transition?

- Net Zero the amount of carbon pushed out = amount sucked in
- Just Transition a process that gets us to net zero in a way that is managed and fair
- Scotland has a net zero target by 2045 (5% reduction in emissions by 2030) but we all need to play our part to achieve that
