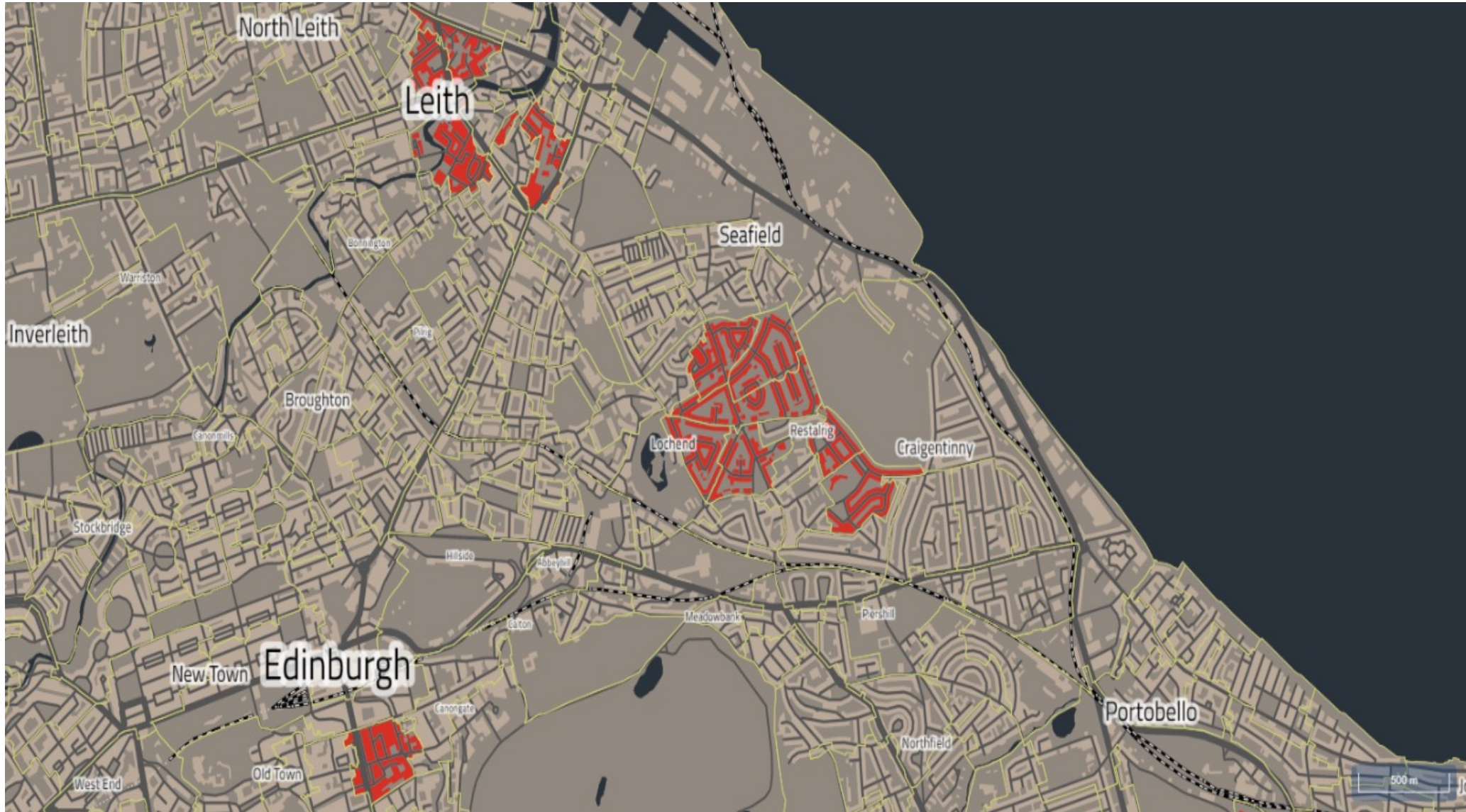

Key Points

- **Key points**
- Participatory Budgeting (PB) in Lochend, Restalrig and Craigentenny has channelled an additional £67000 into the community and delivered new activities that are important to local people.
- Over 400 people were involved in the planning, delivery and voting phases of the project during the two year period.
- P6 and P7 classes at Craigentenny Primary School conducted their own PB exercise resulting in a lego club, period products in toilets, a gymnastics club and a Board game club for £3500
- There are 25 new projects now being delivered in Restalrig, Lochend and Craigentenny after receiving support from the local community.
- 10 people have completed a 6 month planning process and now have training in planning and delivering community democratic processes.
